




Four crime-solving friends face off against a killer in San Francisco in the Women's Murder Club novel that started James Patterson's thrilling series.




Reeling from guilt and grief over a tragic loss, can an ambitious pilot earn the respect she craves?






Available Now On All Platforms- The KEAK Anthology

Dr. K's Author's Blog





As a writer and physicist I have often admired Dr. Niels Bohr. Not only was he a renowned scientist in the field of atomic theory, a Noble Prize winner, and prolific writer, but also a humanitarian.

During WWII he was instrumental in helping people at risk from the Nazi occupation in Denmark to escape to a safer home. He is known to have saved over 4000 lives in addition to that of his family.

He was also suspected to have convinced Werner Heisenberg to delay the German efforts towards the atom bomb thereby turning the tide of the war. His meeting with Heisenberg on Sept. 15, 1941, was reenacted by a Tony winning play on Broadway in the year 2000 entitled "Copenhagen".

New Book on the work of Niels Bohr entitled "From Data To Quanta".

A new book clarifies common misconceptions about the work of the Danish physicist.

Physicists have debated whether reality is more like sand or water since Max Planck introduced the concept of the quantum to the world.

Planck's famous 1900 discovery that energy is grainy — at least when absorbed or emitted — moved him to label those smallest bits of energy grains "quanta." But he felt that once discharged, as in light from a fire, those grains combined into smooth, continuous waves, just as water resembles a smooth liquid to human sense. Einstein, on the other hand, believed that light quanta moved through space on their own, behaving like the particles that would later be known as photons.

By the mid-1920s, both the wave and particle conceptions of light had garnered experimental support, with the additional conundrum that electrons — purportedly particles — could sometimes disguise themselves as waves.
