Far from his first love he suffered greatly yet respected his mother's wishes. He practiced law and also wrote as the editor of a Greek-English NYC newspaper for many years.



Dr. K's On This Day in Space What is A Nebula?

A nebula is a very massive cloud made up of dust, gas, plasma, helium, and hydrogen. Nebulae are also considered nurseries as this is where stars are created or born. Nebula is the Latin word for cloud, and until the 1920s distant galaxies were also referred to as nebulae as well. Nebulas' size ranges from millions of miles to hundreds of light-years in diameter.

Stars are formed as part of an amazing recycling process, in which gravity shapes new stars from the gas and dust expelled by old stars. Once formed, massive young stars regulate the formation of lower-mass stars with their powerful winds, blowing gas and dust out of some areas while compressing it in others. As stars form, they are hidden inside their "parent" cocoons of dust that visible light cannot penetrate, but they emit infrared light that passes through the dust clouds and can be detected by infrared telescopes.
